A wealthy philanthropist hires a struggling author with a secret government past to investigate a cold murder case and uncover the buried secrets of a powerful political family.

SYNOPSIS

A Fine Line is a story about Sebastian Drake, a struggling author trying to come up with his next story idea. Drake receives an unexpected visit from a man interested in hiring him for a project, who thinks he has just the solution to Drake's writing challenges. He also believes that Drake's past life with a shadow government organization is a valuable asset. His proposition to Drake is simple: become a hired agent to investigate a cold murder case involving one of Chicago's most powerful political families. The job comes with a decent paycheck and the types of real-life experiences that can form the basis for great fiction stories. This story is about a man who has found a new lease on life and leads a dual existence as an aspiring author and a rogue vigilante. His biggest challenge is keeping intact the fine line between reality and fiction.



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


CHARACTERS


Thomas Engel: A wealthy citizen seeking an elusive murderer

Modern-day large city: From seedy lofts to polished mansions, the city is a character itself, revealing what thrives in the cracks of privilege and politics.





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VISUAL STYLE

Dan Burns is an award-winning screenwriter, author, and independent filmmaker dedicated to telling character-driven stories that blend emotional depth with cinematic precision. His short film *Come Out, Wherever You Are*—adapted from his acclaimed story collection *No Turning Back: Stories*—has been an official selection at more than 70 festivals and has earned 25 awards, including Best Short Film, Best Screenplay, and Best Director. Burns brings a distinct literary voice to each project and a deep understanding of structure, character, and tone. As the founder of 136 Productions, he develops original content for the screen and stage, drawing on his experience as the author of seven books. He splits his creative time between Chicago and Montana, where the landscapes and solitude often find their way into his stories.
